FireFly FF

- Also hazes birds, prevents roosting within 30 foot radius.
- Spins in 1+ mph wind. Stainless steel ball bearing swivel resists salt spray and adverse weather.
- Impact resistant & UV-stabilized acrylic rated for -40 F to 158 F.



FireFly HW

- Alternate design of FireFly for locations where sustained high winds prevail.
- No moving parts. Sways with the line (does not spin).



BirdMark

- Similar performance to FireFly FF, but flutters instead of spinning.
- Circular pattern of holes works well in a wide range of winds.
- · Lower cost alternative.

Making Hazards Visible to Birds

Avian research has shown that birds react to both motion and light. FireFly and BirdMark incorporate several motion and light features:

- In winds above 1 mph, FireFly FF spins and BirdMark flutters.
- Research at Cornell University shows that birds can see both visible and ultraviolet light.
 FireFly and BirdMark are highly visible to birds in both parts of the spectrum.
- Highly reflective decals refract sunlight and provide a "sparkle effect" visible to birds up to 1500 feet away.
- Luminescent material emits visible light 10–16 hours after dusk, and in low light or fog conditions, when birds are most vulnerable.

FireFly® & BirdMark®: Fast and Simple Installation





1. Open the patented SnapFast® clamp.



- 2. Attach the SnapFast installation tool (sold separately) to a hot stick, and place the open SnapFast clamp on top (bird diverter not shown).
- 3. Push against line until the clamp snaps closed.
- 4. To remove, hook a finger hole on the clamp and pull down.
- 5. Recommended spacing: FireFly every 30 feet BirdMark every 15 feet



FireFly & BirdMark can also be installed by drone.

- Discourages birds from roosting, perching, and building nests.
- · Prevents damage & outages

FireFly WM Wood Mount Bird Hazing

- FireFly FF bird diverter attached to a durable, yet lightweight metal brace that mounts to wood poles and other surfaces.
- Discourages birds from landing, perching, or building nests within a 30 foot radius.

Woodpecker Hazing

- Woodpeckers are very territorial and steer clear of wood utility poles and other structures when they see our birds on the scene!
- Choose from Pileated Woodpecker (left) or Northern Flicker.
- Heavy duty aluminum printed both sides with special UV paint seen clearly by woodpeckers.
- · Protective clear coat.
